



Mentoring Children of Prisoners: Caregiver's Choice Mentoring Relationship Milestones and Payment Amounts

In Caregiver's Choice, the mentoring program is responsible for recruiting, screening and training a mentor and supporting the mentoring match. For each Caregiver's Choice child served, the mentoring program will receive \$1,000 in four installments over a twelve-month period, linked to key milestones in the mentoring relationship. The criteria for each milestone and the related payment amount are described below.

Milestone	Criteria to be Met	Payment
1	Mentor has completed screening process. Mentor has attended initial mentor training. Mentee has attended orientation/training. Mentee has completed baseline survey. Mentee has been matched with mentor. Mentor and mentee have met at least once.	\$300
2	Milestone 1 has been met. Mentor and mentee have been matched for a minimum of 3 months. In the last 3 month period the following activities have taken place at regular intervals: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Program coordinator has provided case management (in person or by phone) through at least 6 total contacts with the mentor, mentee and/or caregiver); ▪ Mentor and mentee have spent a minimum of 10 hours together; and ▪ Mentor and mentee have met in person a minimum of 3 times. 	\$200
3	Milestone 2 has been met. Mentor and mentee have been matched for a minimum of 6 months. In the last 6 month period the following activities have taken place at regular intervals: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Program coordinator has provided case management (in person or by phone) through at least 10 total contacts with the mentor, mentee and/or caregiver; ▪ Mentor and mentee have spent a minimum of 20 hours together; and ▪ Mentor and mentee have met in person a minimum of 6 times. 	\$200
4	Milestone 3 has been met.	\$300

	<p>Mentor and mentee have been matched for a minimum of 12 months.</p> <p>Mentee completed the Relationship quality survey after being matched for 9 months.</p> <p>Mentee has completed the post survey.</p> <p>Mentor has completed the post survey.</p> <p>Mentoring program has completed the satisfaction survey.</p> <p>In the last 12 month period the following activities have taken place at regular intervals :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Program coordinator has provided case management (in person or by phone) through at least total 18 contacts with the mentor, mentee and/or caregiver;▪ Mentor and mentee have spent a minimum of 40 hours together.; and▪ Mentor and mentee have met a minimum of 12 times.	
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
