

# Information for Incarcerated Mothers

Children who have a mother in prison need support from their family and their community. They are affected by the incarceration of their mothers in many ways. They miss their mothers, they struggle with whom to talk to about their feelings, and they worry about their lives. As an incarcerated mother, you and your child's caregiver can work together to connect your child to the resources he or she may need to better adjust to the separation from you, to do well in school, and to prepare for the future.

Mentors can help children of incarcerated parents in many ways. Through Mentoring Children of Prisoners: Caregiver's Choice your child can be matched with a caring adult mentor. The enclosed brochure discusses how a mentor can help your child and how the program works.
